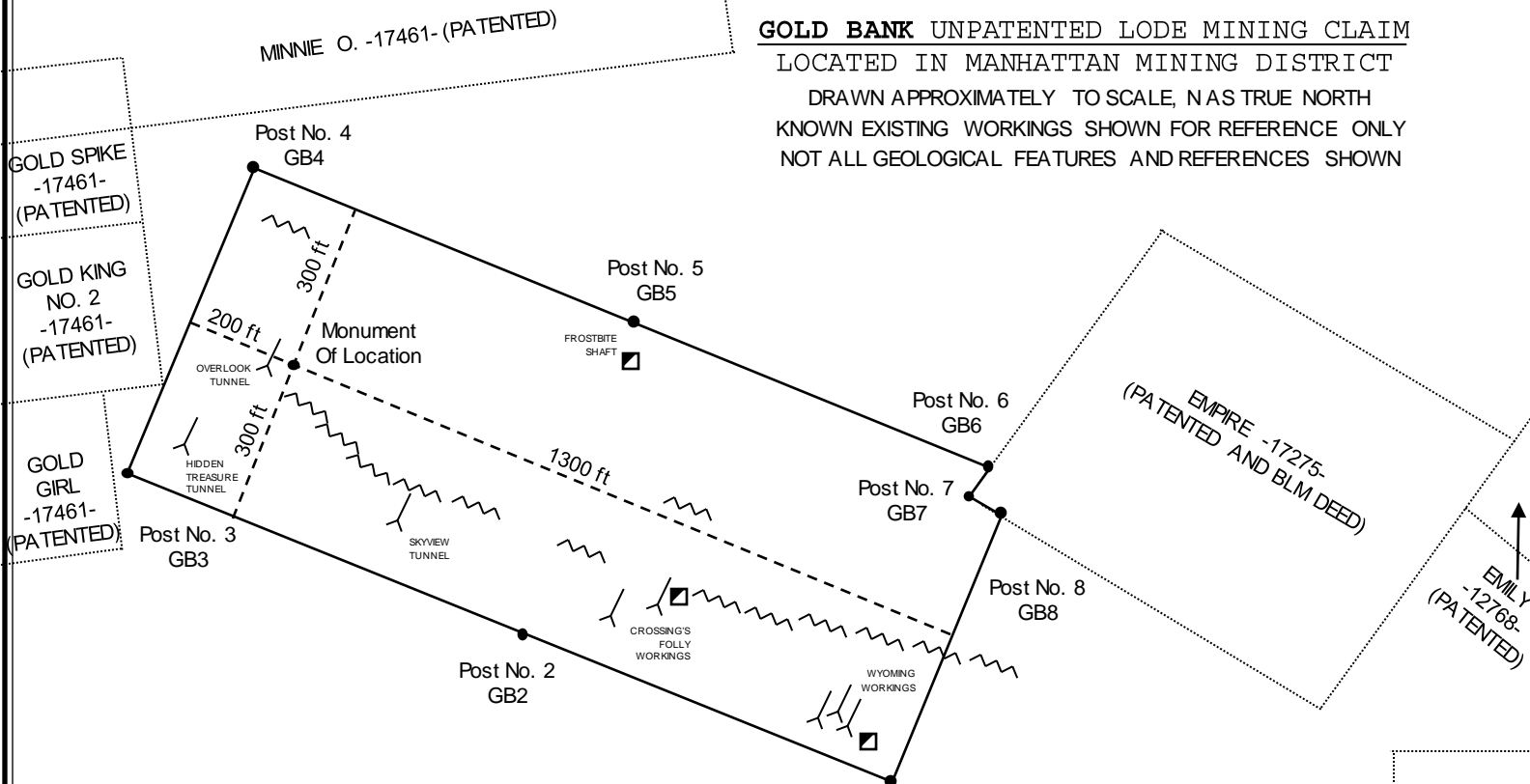

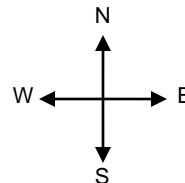

 INDICATES UNDISCOVERED VEINS MAY BE PRESENT, UNCONFIRMED
SPECIMENS OF CHALCOPYRITE RECOVERED ON SURFACE (RAINBOW PYRITE)
WHICH IS KNOWN AS A PRIMARY ORE IN THE DISTRICT FOR GOLD (NO ASSAYS
HAVE BEEN MADE ON THESE SPECIMENS)
